**Why?** After three years of DJing, Made in June is on the verge of a major breakthrough. She has played clubs across Amsterdam (Club Up, Bitterzoet) and also in London (Mau Mau) and France (Paris Paris). With her promo tape finished and a list of upcoming gigs, she's ready to entertain you.

**When?** Closing party of the International Film Festival at Dado (Rotterdam) on 2 February; Jokkies at Club Up on 4 February; Flexbar on 6 February; Meisjes Zonder Smaak at Bitterzoet on 25 February.

**Westerpark or Vondelpark?** Vondelpark. I grew up next to it, so it was like my backyard.

**Alcohol or drugs?** Alcohol! No drugs for me, I don't need them. I get my own natural ecstasy.

**Beer or vodka?** Vodka. Although last time I drank it, I can't seem to remember the end of it.

**Club Royal Winston Kingdom**, 23.00-04.00, €5. A new club night, featuring 'banging fidget house, rave and ghetto-tech'. For this opening night, they have the appropriately named Royal Bastards performing, followed by DJs Sickboy and Jamie Fanatic.
